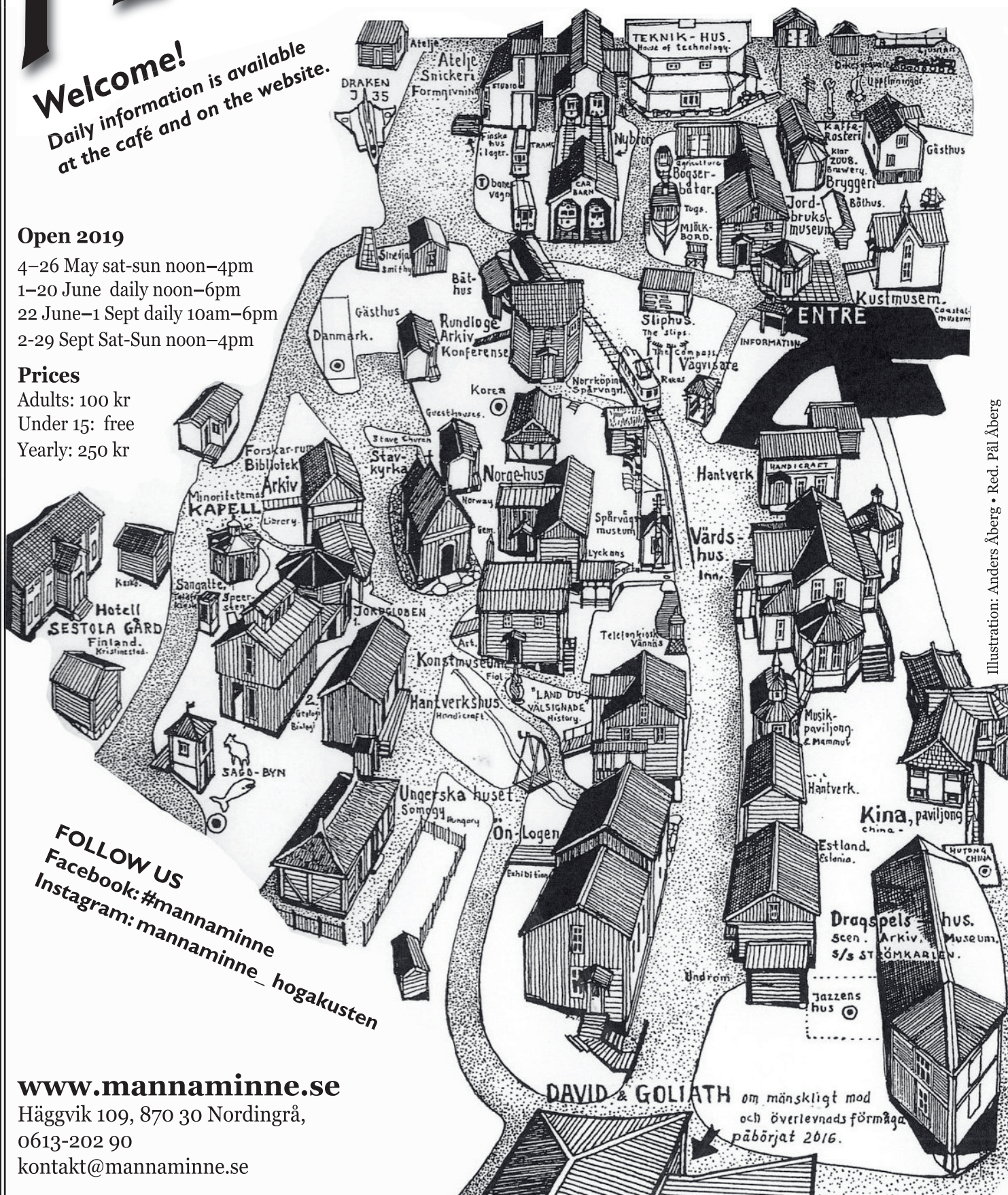

Café Mannaminne was built from 1980 by artist Anders Åberg (1945-2018) and his wife Barbro, with the help of their friends Lisa Carlsson and Dag Wallin. The idea behind it was to make a meeting place for the neighbourhood with and for art; arts and crafts, far from the big cities - a way to bring the world to Nordingrå. Mannaminne, in collaboration with many artists and carpenters, became a constantly growing work of art that now consists of more than 50 houses from far and wide. Here meets nature and culture, art and technology, local and global, history and future, small and large. The Globe House, the China Pavilion, the Estonian House, the Accordion House, the Hungarian Farm, the Art Museum, the Round Hay Barn, the Stave Church, the Norwegian House with Youth Hostel, the Technology House, the Agricultural Museum, the Minority Chapel and the Coastal Museum. Hotel Mannaminne, the Sestola Mansion, built after a Finnish Mansion, where every room is a unique piece of art. A number of houses were moved from the neighborhood, some from abroad, others were built on site. They are all filled with typical decorations, cultural history and exhibitions.

Together with collected and specially made objects such as boats, streetcars, a paper clip, a fighter plane, cars, up to and including a mammoth, Mannaminne is a unique place for thoughts and inspiration.

In Café Mannaminne you can eat delicious pastry (fika) and simple dishes. In the Craftshop you will find local handicrafts. In Hotel Mannaminne you can spend the night in a work of art. The Bed & Breakfast is located in the Norwegian house. In addition, there are 3 simple summer houses for 4 to 6 people.

Don't forget to take a trip to the top of the Stortorget mountain. Up there you have one of the most beautiful views on the World Heritage High Coast. You look over mountains, sea and farmlands. This trip is very recommended!
